RULES AND CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- 1 **DRESS:** Cross country dress and hard hat/crash hat with a chin strap and retaining harness permanently fixed to the shell. **Back/Body Protectors are COMPULSORY.** Hard hats **MUST** be worn at **ALL TIMES** by all mounted persons. Correct footwear; no muckers, trainers or chaps allowed. Medical armbands are strongly recommended.
- 2 **ELIMINATION** Three refusals at one fence. Any competitor eliminated must leave the course at a walk immediately.
- 3 **ANY COMPETITOR** in difficulty at a fence must make way for following competitors who wish to overtake.
- 4 **HORSES/PONIES** can be ridden only once in any one class and in no more than two classes. Horses/ponies must be four years or over.
- 5 **NUMBERS** to be collected from the Secretary on the day. **A £5 refundable deposit will be charged on the day - EXACT MONEY PLEASE**
- 6 **ENTRY FEES** will only be returned on production of a current veterinary or doctor's certificate. In the event of cancellation fees will be returned less £2 per horse/pony on receipt of SAE within 14 days.
- 7 **OBJECTIONS** Any objection must be made in writing to the Secretary accompanied by a deposit of £10 and lodged within 15 minutes of the incident. This is refundable if objection is sustained.
- 8 **THE DECISION OF THE ORGANISERS IS FINAL** and the committee reserve the right to cancel and refuse entries or amend any of the conditions.
- 9 **DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY:**
The Organisers or Landowners shall not be liable for any claim for loss or damage to competitors, onlookers, their servants, horses, ponies or other animals, vehicles, equipment or any other item in connection with the show or on the showground, however caused. Competitors are to satisfy themselves that they have assessed the risk factor in competing in the show. You are advised to walk the course before your class and make a decision regarding your ability to safely jump each fence. It is a condition of entry that each participant will satisfy themselves as to their own ability to ride safely and indemnify the Organisers against any accident or loss however caused.
- 10 **NO COMPETITOR** may practice over any part of the course. If they are seen doing so they will be eliminated.
- 11 **ALL DOGS must** be kept on a lead at all times **including** walking the course. This is in the interest of the safety of the rider.
- 12 **ONLY COMPETING** horses/ponies allowed to be ridden on the ground.
- 13 **BHS Riding Club rules** apply
- 14 **MEMBERSHIP** of the Club is determined by the status of the rider rather than the owner of the horse.
- 15 **ENTRANTS** who are not Full members of HDRC are made Associate Members for the day of the event only. The subscription is incorporated in the charges set out in the schedule.
- 16 **HEALTH & SAFETY:** Reasonable precautions will be taken to ensure health and safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents and obey the lawful instruction of the Organisers, Officials and Stewards.

THIS EVENT is a QUALIFIER for the FINALS of the SOUTH ESSEX INSURANCE BROKERS BHS CROSS COUNTRY CHAMPIONSHIPS 2010.

In the nominated qualifying classes, the TWO highest placed riders (or two highest placed Pairs) who are BHS Gold Members ON THE DAY OF THE QUALIFIER will qualify for the Final. In the event of a combination of horse/pony and rider already having qualified, the qualification will pass down to the next eligible competitor. You must provide the Entries Secretary with your BHS membership number when you enter the qualifier but we recommend you also carry your membership card on the day. Non-members may enter qualifying classes. Competitors placed 1st and 2nd who are not Gold member on day of the competition will also have the opportunity to qualify by becoming a Gold member of the BHS up to 7 days after the qualifier date. This will not pass down and does not affect the highest placed BHS members. All competitors must have had a clear jumping round, time penalties would be allowed but competitors couldn't qualify with jumping penalties. Competitors who compete on day tickets would still be able to qualify for the BHS Cross Country Championship as long as they were not placed 1st-6th at the BE Event prior to qualifying for the BHS Championship. Rules at qualifiers may differ from those at the Finals. Classes at the Finals will be Novice and Pairs (both max. 2'9") and Open (max. 3'3").
