### **RULES AND CONDITIONS OF ENTRY**

- 1 DRESS: All riders must wear skull caps or approved hard hats with a chinstrap and retaining harness permanently fixed to the shell for all three phases.**

- NB: Skull Caps AND Body Protectors are COMPULSORY for Cross Country Phase. Medical armbands are strongly recommended. Hard hats must be worn at all times by all mounted persons.**
- 2 PARKING of all vehicles permitted only where directed.**
  - 3 IN CROSS COUNTRY any competitor in difficulty at a fence must make way for following competitors who wish to overtake.**
  - 4 NUMBERS to be collected from the Secretary on the day. A £5 refundable deposit will be charged on the day - EXACT MONEY PLEASE**
  - 5 ENTRY FEES will only be returned on production of a current veterinary or doctor's certificate. In the event of cancellation fees will be returned less £3 per horse/pony on receipt of SAE within 14 days.**
  - 6 OBJECTIONS Any objection must be made in writing to the Secretary accompanied by a deposit of £10 and lodged within 15 minutes of the incident. This is refundable if objection is sustained.**
  - 7 THE DECISION OF THE ORGANISERS IS FINAL and the committee reserve the right to cancel and refuse entries or amend any of the conditions.**
  - 8 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY:  
The Organisers or Landowners shall not be liable for any claim for loss or damage to competitors, onlookers, their servants, horses, ponies or other animals, vehicles, equipment or any other item in connection with the show or on the showground, however caused. Competitors are to satisfy themselves that they have assessed the risk factor in competing in the show. You are advised to walk the course before your class and make a decision regarding your ability to safely jump each fence. It is a condition of entry that each participant will satisfy themselves as to their own ability to ride safely and indemnify the Organisers against any accident or loss however caused.**
  - 9 NO COMPETITOR may practice over any part of the course. If they are seen doing so they will be eliminated.**
  - 10 ALL DOGS must be kept on a lead at all times including walking the course. This is in the interest of the safety of the rider.**
  - 11 HORSES/PONIES must be four years or over and may compete only once.**
  - 12 BHS Riding Club rules apply**
  - 13 MEMBERSHIP of the Club is determined by the status of the rider rather than the owner of the horse.**
  - 14 ENTRANTS who are not Full members of HDRC are made Associate Members for the day of the event only. The subscription is incorporated in the charges set out in the schedule.**
  - 15 HEALTH & SAFETY: Reasonable precautions will be taken to ensure health and safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents and obey the lawful instruction of the Organisers, Officials and Stewards.**
