8.30 - 10.45am CLEAR ROUND JUMPING - Tickets on the gate.

Jump by 9 am: £3 per round. Jump after 9 am: £5 per round.

NB: This applies to time you jump - NOT time you purchase tickets.

Fences will be very small and suitable for young horses/novices. Will not exceed height of class 1. Limited number of tickets sold to ensure Class 1 starts on time.

11am prompt

CLASS 1 NOVICE JUMPING

For horse & rider combination not to have won more than £50. Height of fences in first round - 2'3" approx

TO FOLLOW:

CLASS 2 ADVANCED NOVICE

For horse & rider combination not to have won more than £100. Height of fences in first round - 2'6" approx

CLASS 3 TOP SCORE NOVICE JUMPING "AmTrust Equine" Royal Windsor Horse Show BRC Championships qualifier (Round 1) - open to members AND non members of British Riding Clubs. SECT. A Junior: 17 & under on 1/1/2010 SECT. B Senior: 18 & over on 1/1/2010

Course of obstacles which must be capable of being jumped in both directions. Fences will be built to differing heights and each will display a points value, increasing with height of the fence. NOVICE fences will range from 2' (20 points), 2'9" (120) and the 3' Joker fence worth 200 points. All heights are approximate and course details are left to the discretion of the course designer, judges & officials.

CLASS 4 TOP SCORE INTERMEDIATE JUMPING "AmTrust Equine" Royal Windsor Horse Show British Riding Clubs Champs. qualifier (Round 1) open to members AND non members of British Riding Clubs. **See information above.**
SECT. A Junior: 17 & under on 1/1/2010 SECT. B Senior: 18 & over on 1/1/2010
INTERMEDIATE fences will range from 2'6" (20 points), 3'3" (120) and the Joker (3'6"-3'9") worth 200 points. All heights are approximate and course details are left to the discretion of the course designer, judges & officials.

CLASS 5 SMALL OPEN JUMPING Unrestricted
Height of fences in first round - 3'0" - 3'3" approx

RULES AND CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. YOUR SIGNATURE on the entry form shall be construed as acceptance of these rules.
2. Telephone entries or entries made without the appropriate fee will not be accepted.
3. In the event of cancellation of show £2 per entry will be retained to cover administration costs
4. The Organisers reserve the right to cancel, add to or amend any of the classes they think fit, alter advertised times, refuse entry without stating reasons.
5. Classes will be judged in accordance with BSJA rules and run under Two Phase if entries are large. THE DECISION OF THE JUDGE(S) IS FINAL.
6. Horses/ponies must compete in the order declared at the collecting ring. Any competitor not responding when called will be placed at the end of the list.
7. If the judge is dissatisfied with the rate at which competitors are presenting themselves at the start, he may issue a public warning to competitors. At the end of a three minute interval he may issue a second public warning, and at the end of a further three minutes he may declare the competition closed.
8. No horse/pony under the age of four years may compete, and only horses/ponies competing in the show may be ridden on the show ground.
9. Practice jumps must be jumped from the correct side; failure to do so may result in the competitor being eliminated. Similar action may be taken in the event of misuse of whips, equipment or saddlery.
- 10 All riders MUST wear approved protective headgear which includes retaining harness secured to the shell at more than two points, and which is correctly fastened, whenever mounted. Body protectors are strongly recommended.
- 11 Competitors must wear correct riding dress and are required to parade mounted to receive their awards.
- 12 Objections accompanied by a deposit of £10 must be made in writing to the Secretary within 15 minutes of the incident; the deposit will be forfeited if the objection is not sustained.
- 13 Entrants who are not Full Members of HDRC are made Associate Members for the day of the show only. The subscription is incorporated in the charges set out in the schedule.
- 14 Membership of the Club is determined by the status of the rider, rather than the Owner of a horse/pony.
- 15 **DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY:** The Organisers or Landowners shall not be liable for any claim for loss or damage to competitors, onlookers, their servants, horses, ponies or other animals, vehicles, equipment or any other item in connection with the show or on the showground, however caused. Competitors are to satisfy themselves that they have assessed the risk factor in competing in the show. It is a condition of entry that each participant will satisfy themselves as to their own ability to ride safely and indemnify the Organisers against any accident or loss however caused.
- 16 **HEALTH & SAFETY** Reasonable precautions will be taken at each show to ensure the health and safety of all persons present. For these measures to be effective everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents and obey the instructions of the Organisers, Officials and Stewards.
