ALL CLASSES OPEN TO NON H.D.R.C. MEMBERS

8.30 - 9.45am CLEAR ROUND JUMPING Tickets on gate £5 per round. Fences will be very small and suitable for novices & young horses. Will not exceed height of class 1. A limited number of tickets will be sold to ensure Class 1 starts on time

10am prompt

CLASS 1 NOVICE JUMPING

For horse & rider combination not to have won more than £50. Height of fences in first round - 2'3" approx

TO FOLLOW:

CLASS 2 ADVANCED NOVICE JUMPING

For horse & rider combination not to have won more than £100. Height of fences in first round - 2'6" approx

CLASS 3 STYLE JUMPING For juniors & seniors. Run under BRC rules for RC members AND non members. SNAFFLE BRIDLES ONLY

Riders jump 1 round and are judged on the style of riding. They must salute the judge when entering arena, then canter on both reins until signal to start is given; during this time they will be judged for style on the flat. When jumping the rider is judged on position on take-off, in the air, on landing and in the following stride at each fence. After the round is complete the rider must canter until a signal to finish is given; during this time they will again be judged for style on the flat. No need to salute before leaving arena. Extra marks awarded for rider effectiveness. Spurs are permitted. *Scoring details displayed on day.*

Course of 7 obstacles, height 75-85cms. Optimum speed 350mpm.
For every second or part thereof over the optimum time.....1 penalty
Knocking down any part of an obstacle including wing.....2 penalties
First refusal on the whole course3 "
Second refusal on the whole course6 "
Third refusal on the whole courseElimination
Fall of horse &/or rider, Taking the wrong course, Failing to salute judges, Commencing course before signal, and Leaving arena before the second signal - all result in.....Elimination
Running martingale + rein stops permitted but will incur.....5 penalties

CLASS 4 INTERMEDIATE JUMPING

For horse & rider combination not to have won more than £200. Height of fences in first round 2'9" approx

CLASS 5 SMALL OPEN JUMPING Unrestricted

Height of fences in first round 3' approx

CLASS 6 OPEN JUMPING Unrestricted

Height of fences in first round 3'3" approx

Classes will be run as Two Phase (immediate jump-off) if large entries

ENTRY FEES per class:

HDRC Members £9.00 Non Members £12.00

FIRST AID £3.00 per rider

LATE ENTRIES £3.00 extra per class

***Note:** Class sizes will be strictly limited so early entry is strongly advised. Entries close 28th February.
Late entries only accepted if sufficient room.
Rosettes/prizes according to entries.*

1st-6th in Classes 1, 2, 4, 5 & 6 qualify for the SUNSHINE TOUR UNAFFILIATED SHOW JUMPING CHAMPIONSHIPS at Great Bookham Equestrian Centre, Surrey, on 22nd/23rd September. Qualifiers must be clear in the 1st round. www.sunshinetour.co.uk

RULES AND CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. YOUR SIGNATURE on the entry form shall be construed as acceptance of these rules.
2. Telephone entries or entries made without the appropriate fee will not be accepted.
3. In the event of cancellation of show £2 per entry will be retained to cover administration costs
4. The Organisers reserve the right to cancel, add to or amend any of the classes they think fit, alter advertised times, refuse entry without stating reasons.
5. Classes will be judged in accordance with BS rules (except where stated) and run under Two Phase if entries are large. THE DECISION OF THE JUDGE(S) IS FINAL
6. Horses/ponies must compete in the order declared at the collecting ring. Any competitor not responding when called will be placed at the end of the list.
7. If the judge is dissatisfied with the rate at which competitors are presenting themselves at the start, he may issue a public warning to competitors. At the end of a three minute interval he may issue a second public warning, and at the end of a further three minutes he may declare the competition closed.
8. No horse/pony under the age of four years may compete, and only horses/ponies competing in the show may be ridden on the show ground.
- 9 Practice jumps must be jumped from the correct side; failure to do so may result in the competitor being eliminated. Similar action may be taken in the event of misuse of whips, equipment or saddlery.
- 10 All riders MUST wear approved protective headgear which includes retaining harness secured to the shell at more than two points, and which is correctly fastened, whenever mounted. Body protectors are strongly recommended.
- 11 Competitors must wear correct riding dress and are required to parade mounted to receive their awards.
- 12 Objections accompanied by a deposit of £20 must be made in writing to the Secretary within 15 minutes of the incident; the deposit will be forfeited if the objection is not sustained.
- 13 Entrants who are not Full Members of HDRC are made Associate Members for the day of the show only. The subscription is incorporated in the charges set out in the schedule.
- 14 Membership of the Club is determined by the status of the rider, rather than the Owner of a horse/pony.

- 15 **DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY:** The Organisers or Landowners shall not be liable for any claim for loss or damage to competitors, onlookers, their servants, horses, ponies or other animals, vehicles, equipment or any other item in connection with the show or on the showground, however caused. Competitors are to satisfy themselves that they have assessed the risk factor in competing in the show. It is a condition of entry that each participant will satisfy themselves as to their own ability to ride safely and indemnify the Organisers against any accident or loss however caused.
- 16 **HEALTH & SAFETY** Reasonable precautions will be taken at each show to ensure the health and safety of all persons present. For these measures to be effective everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents and obey the instructions of the Organisers, Officials and Stewards.
